

Expansion of land holdings at the Mount Clifford Project

Bathurst Resources Ltd ("Bathurst") is pleased to announce that it has expanded its land holdings at the Mount Clifford Project by pegging two Prospecting Licences adjacent to its current tenements.

The two new Prospecting Licence applications (P37/7611 and P37/7612) cover approximately 3.7km² and increase the project area by 13% and cover the same prospective greenstone stratigraphy as the existing project, as illustrated in the plan below.

About Bathurst Resources

Bathurst listed on the ASX in December 2007 and is focusing on the Mt Clifford project, 50km northwest of Leonora in Western Australia. The Mt Clifford Project is prospective for gold, nickel and base metal mineralisation and covers approximately 30 square kilometres. The Project is comprised of two tenements with Bathurst having a 20% stake in the tenements and the right to earn up to a 75% interest and a further two tenements which are wholly owned by Bathurst.

Bathurst's Exploration Strategy is designed to test the current targets and any other targets generated for nickel, base metals and gold mineralization. The exploration programmes will consist primarily of geological mapping and rock chip sampling, complemented by the interpretation of satellite imagery and aerial and ground geophysical (magnetic, radiometric and electromagnetic) surveys to define targets to be drill tested.

The information in this report that relates to exploration results, mineral resources or ore reserves is based on information compiled by Mr Richard Monti who is a Director of the company and is a member of the Australasian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy. Mr Monti has sufficient experience which is relevant to the style of mineralisation and type of deposit under consideration and to the activity which he is undertaking to qualify as a Competent Person as defined in the 2004 Edition of the 'Australasian Code for Reporting of Exploration Results, Mineral Resources and Ore Reserves'.
